

## SNMMI Prostate Cancer Outreach Working Group Minutes

March 7, 2018

### Welcome and Introductions

P. Koo called the meeting to order. Quorum was not established. The minutes from the 12/5/17, 1/10/18 and the 2/15/18 meetings will be reviewed during the next conference call.

#### 1. Men's Health Network PCORI Grant Proposal

L. Budzinski reported that she and F. Almaguel participated in a conference call with Ramon Llamas of Men's Health Network to discuss the grant proposal. F. Almaguel gave a brief report indicating that he is reaching out to various complementary groups such as urologists to increase interest and support. F. Almaguel and R. Llamas will continue to identify possible collaborating patient and medical groups to move the proposal forward.

#### 2. Factsheet Edits

P. Koo asked for feedback on the updated *The Prostate Cancer and Molecular Imaging Fact Sheet* which was circulated to the Working Group prior to the call. M. Djekidel recommended that the document be condensed into no more than two pages and include links to more detailed information. The information in the links would be targeted to referring physicians and medical professionals. The Working group discussed revising the document to focus on targeted audiences, with a simpler version for the patient and a more detailed document for the medical community. R. Flavell stated that from a clinical standpoint it is most important to address when molecular imaging should be used for prostate cancer patients.

L. Budzinski pointed out that there is currently patient-orientated information at DiscoverMI.org

L. Budzinski indicated that the fact sheet will be located on the SNMMI website, but a print version is available in PDF format and can be used as a handout at Patient Education Day, the AUA Annual Meeting, and other events. A condensed version with links would be appropriate for the online version while the PDF version could remain intact.

The Working Group approved the edited version of the factsheet as a comprehensive document. P. Koo asked that some images be added to make it more appealing and SNMMI staff work on the graphic design. L. Budzinski will work with E. Parent on additional edits to the document and updating layout with SNMMI staff. The final version of the factsheet will replace the current document on the website.

P. Koo commented that for the long term the document could be updated periodically to address various disease stages and how and when to use molecular imaging.

### 3. Patient Education Day

Dr. Ryan Mark, a urologist at Thomas Jefferson University Hospital in Philadelphia, will speak during the Prostate Breakout session. R. Flavell will present the NM portion. L. Budzinski is working with R. Llamas at Men's Health Network to identify a patient to participate in the program. When the patient is identified, she will arrange a conference call with all of the speakers to discuss the program content in detail.

### 4. ASCO Ancillary Event Planning

L. Budzinski followed up with the American Urological Association regarding hosting a satellite symposium at their annual meeting. It was determined that participation at this event was cost prohibitive.

SNMMI is now working with ASCO on a Friday evening symposium from approximately 6-8:30pm to include dinner. The session will center around how new molecular imaging tools change patient management. P. Koo stressed that the session be interactive, with case presentations and focused on multi-disciplinary care. L. Budzinski will look into an appropriate hotel for the event.

L. Budzinski, P. Koo and R. Flavell will participate in conference call to discuss the details of the program.
