

SNMMI Prostate Cancer Outreach Working Group Minutes

May 9, 2018

Welcome and Introductions

P. Koo called the meeting to order. Quorum was not established. The minutes from the 12/5/17, 1/10/18 and the 2/15/18, 3/7/18 meetings will be reviewed during the next conference call.

1. Updates on Ongoing Activities

- a. **ASCO Ancillary Event**—L. Budzinski had a call May 8 with the four speakers (Drs. Flavell, Slovin, Koo, and Crawford) on the program to discuss content. The program is set for June 1 and promo is underway.
- b. **Men’s Health Network PCORI Grant Proposal**—L. Budzinski reported that she and F. Almaguel have provided all necessary documentation to Ramon Llamas of Men’s Health Network to prepare the grant proposal.
- c. **Patient Education Day**—L. Budzinski reported that the patient speaker for the Prostate Cancer Breakout Session has been identified and the program is complete. She will arrange a conference call with R. Flavell and the other presenters to go over the program. L. Budzinski indicated that one speakers on the program has not responded to any emails. P. Koo asked that she forward the email string to him and he would follow up.
- d. **American Urological Association Exhibiting**—L. Budzinski stated that SNMMI will exhibit at the AUA Annual Meeting and will be promoting a session at AUA by Dr. Andre Iagaru as well as the AUC Fact Sheets for Bone Scans and the ASCO ancillary event. In addition, she will be meeting with AUA’s patient education manager during the event.

2. **2019 Proposals and Submissions**

- a. **AUA-** L. Budzinski explained that it would be beneficial for SNMMI to submit a proposal to get on the program at the 2019 AUA meeting and possibility hold an ancillary event. She reminded the Committee that an ancillary event proposal form is due June 15. B. Savir-Baruch volunteered to help with the development of the proposal.
- b. **ASCO 2019**—Proposals for this will be due in July 2018.

3. **Creation of Patient Guidelines**

- a. L. Budzinski referred the group to the link provided on the agenda (: http://snmmi.files.cms-plus.com/FileDownloads/Patients/FactSheets/Radio_.pdf) to a Factsheet developed by the

SNMMI TRT Working Group. The link provides the patient with a “What to Expect” perspective to thyroid cancer patients undergoing radioiodine I-131 treatment. She asked the Group if they felt it would make sense to develop a similar document for Prostate Cancer screenings or treatments. Generally, the group felt such a document is not needed for this disease area.

4. New Business/Next Meeting

- a. L. Budzinski reminded the group they would be meeting at 12:30pm Saturday, June 23 at the SNMMI annual Meeting and encouraged members to make their travel plans.

She also mentioned an upcoming Men’s Health Network presentation on Capitol Hill relating to guidelines for prostate screening. SNMMI will be present and networking with industry representatives.

Dr. Savir-Baruch asked about the group’s thoughts on using social media and presenting cases without violating privacy laws. Dr. Koo indicated he believes cases can be presented as long as they are properly anonymized. L. Budzinski noted that SNMMI’s Outreach Committee will be holding a session on how to use social media as part of a nuclear medicine practice at the Annual Meeting (1:30 – 3 p.m. Saturday, June 23).
